TIPS ON TOOLS & PRODUCT

1. The paintbrush is the best tool for cleaning electronics
2. Make sure your cloths do not have any rips or loose ends that may cause damage items discussed in this manual

PRODUCT

1. Glass Cleaner

Quick Tip

Never spray directly on to any electronic. Always spray the cloth and always spray away from the electronics



Dust all over with paintbrush, making sure to get under the bells where dust likes to hide. With your dampened cloth (sprayed with glass cleaner), wipe entire area and polish dry



Dust all over with paintbrush, making sure to get around buttons and edges. Wipe with a dampened cloth (sprayed with glass cleaner) and polish dry



Dust all over with paintbrush, making sure to get around buttons and edges. Wipe with a dampened cloth (sprayed with glass cleaner) and polish dry



Wipe with a dampened cloth (sprayed with glass cleaner) Pay close attention to where the headphones rest on the ears and where you will find finger prints



Dust all over with paintbrush, making sure to get around buttons and edges. Wipe with a dampened cloth (sprayed with glass cleaner) and polish dry



Dust all over with paintbrush, making sure to get around buttons and edges. Wipe with a dampened cloth (sprayed with glass cleaner), removing mp3 player to dust base. Wipe mp3 player and place back. Wipe remote.



Use paintbrush to remove settled dust. Take phone out of base and wipe with a dampened cloth (sprayed with glass cleaner), paying close attention to area where mouth and ear connect. Polish screen and wipe number area, careful not to call out. Wipe base with dampened cloth.

If the main base has an answering machine and it shows waiting messages, do not wipe, as you might trigger play or erase (just gently dust with paintbrush). If there are no messages pending use a dampened cloth to wipe down.



Dust all over with paintbrush, making sure to get around buttons and edges. Wipe with a dampened cloth (sprayed with glass cleaner) and polish dry

Always point away from the electronics the remote works so you do not turn anything on by accident

If really dirty, use slightly damp toothbrush to remove dust build up and then wipe with dampened cloth



Wipe with a dampened cloth (sprayed with glass cleaner). Wipe cord



Dust all over with paintbrush, making sure to get around buttons and edges. Pay close attention to fan vents where dust likes to settle. Wipe with a dampened cloth (sprayed with glass cleaner) and polish dry

Wipe cords at back



Use the paintbrush to get in all the crevices going from one side to other to shoot out debris.

Use a dampened cloth (sprayed with glass cleaner) to wipe along top of keys as well as sides and under keyboard



With a dampened cloth (sprayed with glass cleaner), wipe monitor front, sides, back and do not forget base both front and back. Polish dry, making sure you get in the corners



Follow the same procedure for monitor and keyboard



With a dampened cloth (sprayed with glass cleaner), wipe game center, front, back and sides and wipe controllers



Starting to find these at the side of the bed. Spray cloth with glass cleaner and polish entire ebook to remove fingerprints and smudges.



Dust all over with paintbrush, making sure to get around buttons and edges as well as all vent openings. Wipe with a dampened cloth (sprayed with glass cleaner, starting with the screen and then front casing, top, sides and back. Polish dry

Wipe cords at back

Use the paint brush to remove dust between tv and stand where you can.



With paintbrush dust all speakers on speaker stands, gently dusting the woofers to remove built up dust. Dust the front of the equipment under the TV and dust the edges and back of the TV. With a dampened cloth (sprayed with glass cleaner) wipe the front of screen, starting at the top left, going back and forth until you reach the bottom right. Wipe sides top bottom and back. Wipe speaker casings and stands. Wipe the tops of equipment below TV, the sides and backs. Spot clean the front, making sure not to move any dials while cleaning. Carefully lift equipment up to wipe under where dust settles.



Dust computer speakers with paint brush and wipe with dampened cloth (sprayed with glass cleaner). Make sure to wipe backs and in the crevice of the stands.



Dust baby monitors with paint brush and wipe with dampened cloth (sprayed with glass cleaner)



Spray cloth with glass cleaner and wipe entire area back and front. Polish dry
